

Overview

Abuja has been the capital of Nigeria since 1991 and is located in the country's center. The first planned city to be built in Nigeria and the site was chosen for its central location, easy accessibility, mild climate, low population density and the availability of land for future expansion. Abuja is home to the country's National Assembly Complex, the Supreme Court and the Presidential Complex – the residence and offices of the Nigerian president. The city's skyline is characterized by the looming Aso Rock, an enormous monolith.

Over the past several decades, Abuja has undergone rapid urbanization and the real estate sector, which has attracted local and foreign investment, is a major driver of the city's economy. Supported by rapid population growth, rising GDP and expanding household consumption, a wide offering of opportunities have arisen across construction, mining, agriculture and information and communications technology.
